“Ungdomskort” – discount travel on public transport between your home and school

With an “Ungdomskort” you can travel cheaply to and from your place of education in Denmark. As an extra bonus, “Ungdomskort” also gives discount fare on journeys throughout Denmark.

The “Ungdomskort” is a monthly season ticket, which you need to show to the bus driver when you get on the bus and to ticket checkers on board the train or metro.

If you are studying in upper-secondary education

You must first be approved for an “Ungdomskort”. You should seek approval by logging in to www.ungdomskort.dk with your NemID (home page step 1). Remember to have a digital photo of yourself ready. Once you are approved, you will be transferred to the traffic companies’ self-service system “Mit ungdomskort”, where you will order and pay for your card. You will receive your card by post about 14 days after ordering it. (Unfortunately this site is only in Danish, so you may need to ask a Dane for help if you don’t speak Danish.)

Prices

For students in upper-secondary education the “Ungdomskort” costs 12.74 kr. per valid day. For example, a 30 day month costs 382.20 kr. (30x12.74).

Benefits of the “Ungdomskort”

- You have limitless travel between home and school
- You have limitless travel throughout your travel zone – ie: within the coloured area you live in (see map overleaf).
- You can travel by bus through other travel zones for the additional cost of a child ticket, which is approximately half the price of an adult ticket with most traffic companies.
- You can travel by train through other travel zones and get a discount on train tickets throughout Denmark (with DSB and Arriva).
- You can get discount on long-distance coaches throughout Denmark.
